The Board made a strategic choice to keep our staff intact and full-time throughout the year. Consequently, we produced three acclaimed digital productions, which you can read about inside. Numerous online public programs reflected Mosaic's abiding mission and values. Our education department began two new traditions: associate artists taught playwriting classes online for free in partnership with the DC Public Library and an exciting playwriting contest for young people was inaugurated.

The year's success can be attributed to the strong relationship between our excellent administrative staff and the Board's Finance Committee. We worked together closely to monitor expenses while supporting the team's successful application to all Covid relief funding from the City and the Federal Government. We are also immensely grateful for the generosity of all the individuals, foundations and government agencies who continued their financial support of Mosaic. During the 2021 fiscal year, a committee of Board and staff conducted a transparent nationwide search for a new Artistic Director with the help of Arts Consulting Group. Because of Mosaic's artistic track record, proven commitment to Equity, Diversity and Inclusion and the Company's sound financial footing, a trove of qualified candidates applied. Reginald L. Douglas, an extraordinary artist and executive leader, was named Mosaic's new Artistic Director in November 2021. The Mosaic Theater family is thrilled about Reginald's appointment and we can't wait for you to meet him.

PARTY ON THE PLAZA

In May 2021, Mosaic hosted an outdoor concert at Woodrow Wilson Plaza starring Roz White (*Marie and Rosetta*; *Fabulation*). Friends, supporters, artists, staff, and Board members enjoyed a much-needed dose of fellowship – respite from the long Covid timeline that has disrupted the theater world and curtailed so much opportunity for artistic expression.







Ramallah-based playwright Dalia Taha's exquisite short plays, adapted sensitively for the screen by production designer Mona Kasra and Adam M. Kassim, explore distinct slices of Palestinian life. The scenes are at times unsettling, heartbreaking, and humorous as parents, lovers, sisters and friends cope with a decades-long occupation.

EDUCATION

In February 2021, Mosaic's inaugural High School Playwriting Contest winners received a streamed showcase reading of their plays by professional actors and directors. In addition, Mosaic engaged playwrights Gethsemene Herron Coward and James J Johnson to conduct eight sold out online playwriting workshops during the year. The classes were free and open to the public and held in partnership with the DC Public Library.

Playwright in Residence Psalmayene 24 began the development of his very personal new play, *Dear Mapel*, with an online workshop presentation directed by Natsu Onoda Power with live percussion by JabariDC, of Marvel's *Black Panther* movies. The workshop streamed in October 2020 and was reprised in January 2021. A fully-realized World Premier production of *Dear Mapel* opened February 3, 2022.

PUBLIC PROGRAMMING

Online public programming events during FY21 included: GoGo to Vote; Remembering Ruth Bader Ginsburg; #ENOUGH; The Artists of Marys Seacole; The Artists of Remember This: The Jan Karski Story; two Peace Cafes with Seeds of Peace; Storytelling the Beauty & Diversity of Black Manhood; and The Future of Theater in the DMV, featuring Reginald L. Douglas, before he was appointed Mosaic's Artistic Director. An archive is available at mosaictheater.org/alive.

FINANCIALS

Mosaic Theater began FY21 in a healthy financial position in spite of the pandemic; the fiscal year closed with the Company even stronger. Investing in continuity, the Board of Trustees supported the full-time employment of the entire staff; no layoffs or furloughs were implemented. Production expenses for high-quality digital programming were carefully monitored, supporters gave generously to ensure Mosaic's future, and business staff successfully applied for all government pandemic relief opportunities. Overall, the thoughtful and collaborative planning of Board and staff left cash reserves intact and set up the Company well for FY22 and beyond.
